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Bug Color Matching

1. Print and cut out the butterfly, bug, leaf, and flower cards.
2. Match each butterfly to the flower of the same color.
3. Match each ladybug to the leaf of the same color.
4. Name the colors as you match them.
5. A set of extra blank ladybugs have been added for coloring.

Other ideas:

- Turn it into a listening activity. “Can you put the orange ladybug on the purple leaf?”
- Print two sets of cards and use them to play “Memory”.
- Write capital and lowercase letters on the ladybugs and leaves to practice matching letters.
- Write numerals on the butterflies and the equivalent amount of dots on the flowers to practice counting and matching numbers.
